

Message from the Dean

In August 2021 I tried a case to a plaintiff's verdict in the first civil trial held during the pandemic since the Massachusetts courtrooms reopened. Masks were required, except for opening and closing. Voir Dire was cut to one-on-one exchanges at sidebar and limited to a mere three questions by the lawyers. We worked with a jury of 6 rather than the usual 12. Our case Billboard was: Community Health Center, a charitable, not for profit, failed to supervise staff or their residents, and as a result, two staff caregivers stole Lovie Turner's pain medications for three and a half years before getting caught. Lovie suffered in pain, untreated for 1,246 days, with 7433 Percocet stolen. We started the case with an emphasis on foreseeability by using U.S. Department of Justice figures to establish that diversion of prescription drugs by caregivers is a matter of long-standing common knowledge in the industry. With the foreseeability of drug diversion as the backdrop, we repeatedly stressed the system failure of lack of supervision throughout the evidence. In voir dire, we asked jurors: "Have you ever worked in a job where you had to be supervised, or had to supervise others?" When the answer was "yes," we asked them to tell us about that experience.



Although the judge gutted much of our evidence regarding a resident's right to dignity, we proved the message from our Bumper Sticker: *"The bottom line is Meds not administered hurts!"*

The three big emotional buttons were present. Betrayal was evidenced by the defendants' failure to keep their promise to maintain Ms. Turner's dignity and quality of life. Hypocrisy was revealed in defendants' act of registering as a charity but not acting within a charitable purpose. And the Cover Up was revealed by evidence of a deliberately incomplete root cause investigation during which the defendants did not even attempt to interview either the caregivers who stole the drugs or Ms. Turner's own physician.

The Edge System functioned on all cylinders during this trial. As a result, we were able to successfully navigate through and around the various challenges presented to stay on course and reach our destination. As you take your journey through the Edge, keep in mind that the system accommodates a virtual salad bar of options and tools -- as long as you follow the system, you can pick and choose the tools you want or need.

The bottom line -- the system works and I'm living proof!

Tony Seaton is a sixth generation, upper East Tennessean who has practiced in Johnson City for over 40 years.

Tony and the lawyers in his firm have spent hundreds of hours per year developing state of the art trial skills through the Keenan Trial Institute.

In the past 5 years, he obtained a \$4.7 million-dollar verdict in a nursing home abuse case and a \$2.6 million-dollar verdict for a slip and fall injury on ice in an apartment complex. #1: RULES & CASE SELECTION

ules & Case Selection is the sole entrance to the Keenan Trial Institute. Completing Rules give students the right to attend other KTI courses. Imagine leaving the Rules class with the introduction to an opening statement focused on winning your case in the first four and a half minutes.

Trial Lawyers first learn the dirty simple truth that case selection criteria is the most important focus of their case. Students work in small groups to develop Rules for their own case. Instructors introduce Don Keenan's 7 Rules for Writing Safety Rules. The KTI's system for improving trial lawyer's skill forces students to get on their feet and present their Rules to their classmates . Using the "trifecta" tool, students and instructors collaborate to develop and refine their Rules. Armed with safety rules, students give the introduction of the opening to the class. Investing your time to critique fellow students makes you uber efficient in the right way and wrong way to develop safety rules.

The simple truth is the Rules College is the important foundation to the system trial lawyers deserve to win and protect their community's safety by holding wrongdoers accountable.



#2: OPENING & ORDER OF PROOF



avid set out to improve the quality of care, and quality of life, in nursing homes through advocacy and litigation . David 's mother directed a nursing home for almost 35 years. At a young age, David developed a deep

respect for the elderly and felt it was important to preserve their stories. They are the WWII generation that made the country what it is today.

David is considered a pioneer in the field of nursing home abuse and neglect in Massachusetts having obtained the highest verdict for a nursing home death with punitive damages. totaling \$14,447,906,53. This came at a time when Massachusetts did not have voir dire or video depositions, nor was Counsel able to give the Jury a number during closing argument. The law in Massachusetts has since changed, in-part due to David's efforts, and the influence Don had within the Massachusetts area.

David is adamant about preserving the 7th Amendment right to a jury trial. He vigorously contests all attempts at arbitration . Besides nursing home neglect, David has expanded his practice to include catastrophic injury, wrongful death cases, home health care, medical negligence, products liability, transportation vans, auto wrecks, and premises liability.

In July and August 2015, David had the opportunity to try a case with Don. The experience was career changing. The case of Kira Wahlstrom v. JPA Management Services, Inc. et. al. was tried for three and a half weeks. It resulted in a total verdict of \$6,650,829.50. In that case, a young mother was viciously attacked and raped in a Boston hotel parking garage due to the lack of security in the facility. David gained a valuable experience in trying this case with Don, which is shared when he teaches at The College.

Why is David the Dean of KTI? David did what was considered nearly impossible: He successfully

obtained verdicts and settlements for elderly people in a jurisdiction that was one of the hardest, if not the hardest, to get a plaintiff's verdict to change the laws, obtained punitive damages, and succeed as a Trial Lawyer. That was important to Don. Don also saw David's passion for the law, his hard work, and his preparation. It goes hand in hand with the motto Amat Victoria Curam. He is currently Co-dean of the Keenan Trial Institut course, Focus Groups, and has attended almost all of the Keenan seminars and courses since 2009.






TRAVIS SHETLER




